About TUF

Teach Unlimited Foundation (TUF) is a tax-exempt charity in Hong Kong established to advance education opportunities of socially disadvantaged students in Hong Kong through partnership with schools operating in challenging communities. Started in 2011 with only two Program Mentors in one government-aided secondary school, TUF currently operates in four partner schools, serving a total of over 3000 students with a team of eight Program Mentors and one Program Executive.



TUF Education Support and Mentoring Program

With continual demand by more schools for TUF services, we are now recruiting top university graduates as TUF Program Mentors starting in August 2015. Under a scholarship scheme, you will complete a two-year program (August 2015 to July 2017) to acquire leadership and mentoring knowledge and skills, while being placed full-time in one of our partner schools where you will provide customized, non-conventional, inspiring learning experiences to enhance across-the-board learning attitudes and motivation of students. To address individual learning barriers and to support personal growth of students, you will also provide one-on-one structured mentoring to these students, thereby unlocking the door behind which so many of them have been trapped into a vicious cycle of low self-esteem and negative attitude, and helping them develop into self-reliant, self-respecting individuals.

We make no pretense that our program represents a huge challenge and is only for ambitious go-getters, but they will come to recognize that the greatest awards come from the greatest challenges. To qualify for this challenge, you must have attained, or on the track to attain, a Bachelor degree with strong grades. We look for graduates with strong work ethics and self-discipline, who are good communicators with a proven leadership record, strong convictions and a passionate desire for social justice.

Our customized two-year program focuses on leadership, mentoring, learning and teaching strategies. You will be given ample opportunities, scope and discretion to apply these knowledge and skills in real life settings. Throughout the two years, you will be well supported by coaches who will constantly monitor and review your work, and ensure that you succeed in delivering effective, inspirational learning experiences and mentoring to

your pupils. The competencies you gain in the program are universal and transferable to any profession; they will prepare and serve you to take on leadership positions in education or in your subsequent profession.

The scholarship totaling HK\$393,000 will be granted over two years. In addition, you will have 15 vacation days annually, as well as MPF and medical insurance.
